1 Köszöntő -Welcome

In this second Bulletin you can find the very important information about the terms and conditions. Please read it through carefully to avoid problems in the future.

2 Application procedures, deadlines and categories

Here you can find some necessary information about the application possibilities. Whichever option you choose, remember that you can only register through your own scout organization. If you do not know who your Contingent Leader is, please feel free to contact us and we will help in whatever way we can.

The application starts on 01. September 2009.

2.1 Participant (14-18)

The participant must be at least 14 years old at the opening ceremony (August 2nd, 2010.).

That means:

- If the participant was born between August 12, 1992 and August 2, 1996 she/he is one of the lucky ones, who can participate in the 10th. Central European Jamboree, the ConCordia 2010!
- If someone was born after August 2nd, 1996: Unfortunately this camp is only open to those who are older than 13. However, he/she can participate in the 22nd World Jamboree (Sweden, 2011) and the 2012 Central European Scout and Guide Jamboree.

2.2 Patrol Leader (18+)

Take the initiative to bring 8 scouts with you. Prepare them for the Jamboree and make sure that they have a very memorable time there!

One Patrol team consists of 8 participants and one leader. The leader and the participants should be from the same gender.

2.3 Troop Leader (18+)

One troop includes one male and one female patrol. One of the patrol leaders has to be the troop leader as well.

2.4 International Service Team Member (18+)

We need IST help to make this camp possible! There are various tasks which you can sign up for through the website including: giving out food, organizing programs for the participants, making sure the participants are safe, night games, media, and many, many more. On-line applications start during the winter 2009.

2.5 Contingent Management Team Member (18+)

Take the highest responsibility and take part as a member of your national contingent's management team. For more details ask your International Commissioner.

3 Financial Terms and Conditions

3.1 General Terms and Conditions

- The camp dues are to be paid by each national association for its own respective Contingent;
- Registration of National Contingents and their members will take place after the camp dues are received;
- After registration, the Contingents have the option of replacing their registered members or withdrawing some of them and receiving a partial refund. See specific details and restrictions below.

Camp dues for participants, Troop Leaders, and IST's:

- 110 EUR

Camp dues for CMT:

- 75 EUR

The prices given here are based on an exchange rate of 250-300 Ft= 1 EUR. When paying the camp dues actual/current exchange rates will be used.

3.2 Financial deadlines and Payment Conditions

The payment rates are based on the following deadlines:

"A" - Reduced Rate	The preliminary deposit must be paid by Nov-15-2009, the remaining balance by Febr-15-2010
"B" - Reduced Rate	The camp dues must be paid in one deposit by Febr-15-2010
"C" - Basic Rate	The camp dues must be paid in one deposit by March-15-2010
"D" - Premium Rate	The camp dues must be paid in one deposit by Apr-15-2010

After April 15th 2010, payment and/or registration will happen only upon special agreement!

3.4 Refund of the Camp Dues

Based on the table below, and taking into consideration the deadlines for the payment of camp dues, it is possible to reduce the number of participants in each Contingent. If the number of participants in a Contingent drops by a higher percentage rate than indicated in the table below we can not provide any refund.

3.5 Refund for IST's

Camp dues for IST's shall be paid in the manner mentioned above. Upon completion of the camp, every IST will get a refund of 25,-EUR, provided that they completed every assignment and abided by the camp rules for the duration of ConCordia.

Please take special note of the following:

- Make sure that the name of the National Organization is included with the transaction
- The following should also be clearly stated on the transaction fee slip:
 - The CC2010 camp dues
 - The number of participants, and totals for each of the following: PAR= participant, IST= International Service Team Member, LDR= Squad Leader, CMT= Contingent Leader
- Whether the payment is a preliminary deposit or the whole payment, etc.
- The transaction should be paid in EUR for international participants.
- All transfer expenses are to be paid by the national organization of the contingent.
- The date that the transaction is received is the date that is taken into account. Thus, please leave time for the transaction to be completed (International transactions take about 3-5 business days).

4 What is included in the price?

4.1 For participants (PAR) and their patrol leaders(LDR)

- All meals from the 2nd of August 2010 (lunch) until the 12th of August 2010 (breakfast). (One hot meal per a day.)
- 6 days of programmes, including 2 and a ½ days at off site locations;
- 3 main area ceremonies - the Opening Ceremony, the Birthday Party, and the Closing Ceremony;
- Home Hospitality (HoHo) courtesy of Hungarian Scouts from 8th of August until the 11th of August 2010.
- Limited spaces, the number of participating scouts is up to the amount of the participating Hungarian Scout.
- One Hungarian Troop will host 3 other troops.
- The HoHo includes the transportation, meals, programs, and the accommodation.
- Medical care in the case of illness (excluding pre-existing conditions) or accidents, including minor surgery or treatment if necessary during the period of the ConCordia 2010;
- A full ConCordia 2010 participation pack including badge, scarf, hand book (only for LDRs) and personal identity card.

4.2 For IST members

- All meals for the duration of the ConCordia 2010 – the first meal is the lunch on 30th July 2010 and the last meal is lunch / dinner on 12th August 2010.
- Briefing and training (including role specific training) prior to the arrival of participants;
- One free day with activity - depends on the number of IST members;
- 3 main area ceremonies - the Opening Ceremony, the Birthday Party, and the Closing Ceremony
- Medical care in the case of illness (excluding pre-existing conditions) or accidents, including minor surgery or treatment if necessary during the period of the ConCordia 2010;
- A full ConCordia 2010 IST pack including badge, scarf, official IST T-Shirt, and personal identity card.

4.3 For CMT members

- All meals for the duration of the ConCordia 2010 – the first meal is the lunch on 30th July 2010 and the last meal is lunch / dinner on 12th August 2010
- Office with free internet and photocopier (free pages depends on the contingent size)
- 3 main area ceremonies - the Opening Ceremony, the Birth Day Party, and the Closing Ceremony
- Medical care in the case of illness (excluding pre-existing conditions) or accidents, including minor surgery or treatment if necessary during the period of the ConCordia 2010;
- A full ConCordia 2010 CMT-pack including badge, scarf, CMT handbook and personal identity card.



5 Medical Facilities

Those participating in the ConCordia 2010 will be given access to the Jamboree's own medical facilities and, where necessary, we will facilitate access to the local Health Service, but you should note the following:

- This applies for the period from the time of meeting our representatives at the port of entry (or arrival at the Check-In centre) until the time of leaving our representatives at the port of departure (or departure from the Check-In center)
- For those coming from outside Europe, it is likely that treatment provided by the National Health Service will be for a fee and we recommend that you obtain insurance to cover this;
- We recommend that you obtain appropriate insurance coverage (including medical cover) for the period before arrival at the ConCordia 2010 and period after departure from ConCordia 2010 (please note that for some visa applications this insurance may be necessary in any case);
- Those with long term or pre-existing medical conditions should ensure that they make special arrangements to be able to pay for any treatment in relation to such conditions;

Our medical arrangements are based on providing treatment in the Hungary and do not include repatriating anyone to their own country, whether for medical or any other reasons – we recommend you obtain your own insurance to cover this.

6 Rules and Regulations

In order to ensure the safety and comfort of all of those participating in the 10th Central European Scout Jamboree, various rules and regulations will be enforced and by registering to take part in the ConCordia, you confirm your acceptance of these. Below are a number of key rules, but this list is not exhaustive:

1. Each National Scout Organization / Association accepts full responsibility for those of its members taking part in the Jamboree;
2. Patrol / Troop Leaders accept full responsibility for the supervision of all individuals in their Troop.
3. NSOs and Troop / Unit Leaders are responsible for explaining the rules and regulations to the members of the Contingent;
4. For reasons of safety and security, entry to certain areas of the Jamboree site will be restricted;
5. Anyone behaving in a way that is considered to be dangerous or causing offence to others will result in that person being removed from the Jamboree site and no refund of fees will be given;
 1. We will be very strict about the following bad behaviors:
 1. alcohol consumption
 2. all kind of drugs,
 3. smoking under 18
 4. racism
6. Smoking
 1. The whole Jamboree is a non - smoking event.
 2. Smoking is only allowed in marked areas.
 3. Smoking is only allowed for people above 18. (It is a governmental rule.)
 4. Smoking under 18 is only allowed if the parents of the participant allowed the smoking for his/her children. In this case the "Smoking Form" has to be filled out, signed by the parent(s), and showed up at the Check-in upon arrival.
 5. Water-pipes are not allowed at all.
7. Alcohol
 1. Alcohol consumption during the whole Jamboree (even during off site programmes and HoHo) is strictly forbidden for everybody even for persons above 18.
 2. Possession of alcohol is not allowed and in the event that it is found in anyone's possession that person will be sent home and it will be taken away and only returned at the end of the camp.
 3. Breaking this rule: that person will be removed from the Jamboree site and no refund of fees will be given;
8. Drugs
 1. Any kind of drugs (pills, hashish, cocaine, space-cakes, joints, cigarettes etc...) can not be consumed, nor will the excuse that „I just had it in my pocket" be accepted. Breaking this rule will result in it being reported to the police and that person being removed from

- the Jamboree site and no refund of fees will be given;
9. Safe sex
 1. The camp administration leaves the matter of addressing whatever ethical or moral questions may arise in this area to the leaders of individual contingents. Condoms will not be available for purchase at the camp. Therefore, each contingent must decide for itself its own policy regarding safe sex for its youth and must bring condoms (or not) accordingly.
 10. Racism
 1. Jamboree is a peaceful and happy gathering among scouts. One of its aims is to promote an atmosphere where people can live together from different nations with various customs as well.
 2. We ask all of the attendants not to bring any objects (music, t-shirts, etc.) which might create unhappy feelings in other nations.
 11. The Staff of the ConCordia 2010 reserves the right to exclude any group or individual from the Jamboree site and, wherever appropriate, the Head of Contingent will be involved with such a decision;
 12. Any costs arising from the exclusion of the group or individual will be the responsibility of the persons involved and complaints or requests for compensation will not be considered.

7 Copyright

In order to follow correct procedures to ensure that we protect the interests of participants at the 10th Central European Scout Jamboree, The Hungarian Scout Association media outlets and the video / photography crew during filming / shooting of the Jamboree, we need to obtain consents under Part II of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 (and any equivalent enactments or provisions elsewhere in the world). By registering for the Jamboree, you confirm that for all those that you are entering data for you have obtained the appropriate consent and in particular you confirm that:

1. In respect of any recording for inclusion in the 10th Central European Scout Jamboree video and /or photographs for The Hungarian Scout Association that the individuals that you are entering data for have agreed to waive their personal rights in relation to such products;
2. Permission is given for The Hungarian Scout Association and its licensees or assignees, to use the motion pictures and / or stills from the picture or stills taken during the shooting of the picture and any photographs in which any individual appears for all advertising and / or publicity, and / or editorial purposes in connection with the above for worldwide distribution in perpetuity;
3. This agreement and all matters relating to it shall be governed by Hungarian Law and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Hungarian Courts.

8 Data Protection

1. In order to successfully organise and run the 10th Central European Scout Jamboree, the Hungarian Scout Association needs to gather and keep certain "sensitive personal data" (for example details of medical conditions, disabilities, religious or other beliefs, special dietary requirements, and so on) and you should note the following:
2. By registering to take part in the Jamboree, you give your explicit consent to the holding of "sensitive personal data" for purposes related to the organisation and running of the Jamboree;
3. If you are entering data on behalf of others, you confirm that you have obtained their consent for us to hold their "sensitive personal data";
4. Any personal information that we hold will not be shared or sold to any other company or organization.
